New Farm Construction Plan Review Checklist

PLAN REVIEW FOR NEW FARMS

When a producer has applied for a permit to milk, construction and equipment plans must be submitted BEFORE construction begins. Completion of "Application to Install or Modify a Milk System" must also be completed. Approval of all plans and applications must be received before construction may begin. Plans should include the following:

1. Blueprints should include:

- o milkhouse and barn dimensions & layout
- o location of windows and doors
- o restroom or utility room if applicable (restrooms must have self-closing doors)
- o finish on walls, ceilings and floors
- o drain locations & type (trapped)
- location of light fixtures
- o cowyard location and size
- o cattle housing location, size and type
- o location and type of water supply

2. Milkhouse requirements and locations:

- wash vats and hand wash sink
- light fixtures
- o bulk tank
- hoseport
- o location of tube or plate coolers, if used
- o milk receiver group
- o water heater (adequate size and temperature)
- o heating and ventilation system (vent locations and exhaust fans)

3. Water supply:

- o Type of well or supply
- Type of stock water tanks or fountains
- Use of vacuum breakers
- Use of high pressure washers

4. Waste Disposal

- o drain outlets (discharge to septic system?)
- septic system (separate from barn system)
- o manure storage and handling (storage tanks, pits, lagoons, push-off area)
- o must meet all state and local health & plumbing codes

5. Milking area:

- o Size and type of milk operation (barn, parlor)
- Milking equipment used (design, materials, and layout-3A and PMO requirements)
- o Location of calf pens, maternity pens, horse stalls, etc (if applicable)
