



The NDA does not promote the use of select hemp seed varieties. This list simply illustrates which varieties have been grown within the state and have been deemed eligible for industrial hemp. The NDA does not endorse the use of one variety over the other and will not recommend varieties for growers. This list in no way declares that each variety will maintain a THC concentration of <0.3%. It merely identifies the varieties that have been grown and have tested in accordance with state/federal law within the respective production regions. Bear in mind that compliance testing was conducted specifically for the $\Delta 9$ -THC molecule and does not account for THC-A or Total potential THC, post-decarboxylation.

When arranging a purchase, ensure that you file a "materials order form" with the Department of Agriculture and send the seed directly to the Department headquarters in Sparks, NV with attention addressed to the "Industrial Hemp Program." Be aware that the Department will have to hold seed until licensure is issued.
