

The Healthy Hunger-Free Kid Act of 2010 put into place that any school operating a Child Nutrition Program must have a School Wellness Policy in Place.

- > Training and technical assistance
- School Wellness Compliance
- Oversight of Nevada School Wellness Initiatives

Your Role as School Wellness Coordinator

School Site Level Coordinator

- Middle man between District School Wellness Coordinator and School Site
- School Wellness
 Champion
- Contact person for all School Wellness related matters at your school site
- Reporting agent for annual School
 Wellness Policy assessment

- Know your local school wellness policy (LSWP)
- Start Small
- Recruit help
- Market your LSWP
- Know resources available
- Walk the Talk





Know your LSWP!- Cheat Sheet

- School day = Midnight to 30 min after instructional day ends.
- Governs all food given away, sold and marketed**

Check LSWP for exemption days

Does not include SBP, NSLP, ASSP

Competitive Foods

- Only Smart Snacks allowed
- Exemption days do <u>not</u> apply to any foods sold or used in fundraisers

Physical Activity

> 30 minute opportunity daily

Meal Consumption Times

- > 15 minutes in seat time to consume breakfast
- > 20 minutes in seat time to consume lunch



Know your LSWP!- District Goals

Each District has 3 School Wellness Policy Goals:

- 1. Nutrition education and promotion goal
- 2. Physical activity goal
- 3. Other school-based wellness related goal


Know your LSWP!-Reporting

• Every 3 years

School Wellness Policy must be reviewed

• Annually

- Site-Level assessment on LSWP implementation due by June 30th
 - ✤ Goal Progress
 - ✤ Meeting information
 - Site implementation questions

- Identify trouble area(s)
- Develop a game plan

- Form committee
- Delegate duties

Students

- Include nutrition standards into lesson plans
- Conduct mini audits
- Students assess and decides what is in vending machines

- Share information with Students, Staff, and Parents
 - District school wellness goals
 - School site progress on district goals
 - School wellness initiatives
 - Staff wellness initiatives
 - Annual school site assessment
