For most of the following quarantines, shipments from infested areas to non-infested area require a certificate of quarantine compliance, phytosanitary certificate or limited permit. Infestation areas are highly temporal in nature, frequent reference to current APHIS quarantine areas. Contact the Nevada Department of Agriculture if you have questions about the certification requirements for shipments of nursery stock from Nevada to other states.

301.32 Fruit Flies, all genera of the Family Tephritidae. Regulated articles from infested areas require a LP.

301.38: Black Stem Rust- Affects *Berberis and Mahonia* Certificate of quarantine compliance or limited permit required to ship to above States with PR(protected) status

301.45: Gypsy Moth- Affects Trees and Shrubs, Wood, Equipment- Requires LP or CQC from the states listed above

301.48: Japanese Beetle- affects a wide variety of plants, movement from infested areas require a CQC. Air transport of regulated articles from infested to non-infested areas also require a CQC.

301.50: Pine Shoot Beetle: Affects Pine, living, cut, bows, or wood-Requires CQC or LP

301.51: Asian Long Horned Beetle: Affects all wood products –Requires LP or CQC

301.52: Pink Bollworm: Affects cotton, kenaf and okra-requires LP, CQC during certain shipping dates.

301.53: Emerald Ash Borer: Affects all plant parts of hardwoods-Requires CQC or LP

301.55: South American Cactus Moth: No *Opuntia* species of any type may be exported from the listed states.

301.74: Plum Pox: All plant parts of stone fruits-movement outside quarantine zones prohibited.

301.75 Citrus Canker: Affects all *Citrus, Poncirus* and *Fortunella*: CQC or LP required to move through non-infested areas

**301.76 Citrus Greening:** Affects most genera of the family Rutaceae. All plant parts affected. Requires LP.  
**301.80: Witchweed:** Affects soil, many vegetables and packing containers-Requires LP or CQC  
**301.81: Imported Fire Ant:** Affects All Plant material, non commercial soils and some equipment-Requires PC or CQC.  
**301.85: Golden Nematode:** Affects soil, potatoes, sod, bulbs-CQC or LP required  
**301.86: Pale Cyst Nematode:** Affects Solonacea root crops, soil, equipment and hay. Requires LP or CQC.  
**301.87: Sugarcane Diseases:** Sugarcane plants or products- CQC or LP required  
**301.89: Karnal Bunt:** Affects wheat, containers that move wheat-CQC or LP required  
**301.91: European Larch Canker:** All plant parts of *Larix* or *Pseudolarix*- CQC or LP required  
**301.92: Sudden Oak Death:** Affects soil, nursery stock, plant parts, consult detailed list of genera affected-consult details of Regulation

**Federal Order: Light brown apple moth.** Affects shipments of nursery stock and other commodities *originating in* California and Hawaii.
