Board Update

- Reclassification of Metrologist and succession plan
 - Mary and James finished Metrology training
 - Identified a southern Nevada Metrologist, first of three trainings will be in Feb
- Achieved reaccreditation of the Metrology Lab in late Dec
- Three new Mass Comparators
 - Capabilities from .1g to 600kg with accuracies down to .000001g
 - Currently at echelon III but have echelon II and I capabilities
- Hired a Weights & Measures (WM) inspector in Elko who is fully trained.
- Livestock scales were completed with few hiccups
- We are seeing a rise in complaints due to better access to the department
- Both W&M inspectors have completed Train the Trainer
 - Secured a training grant from NCWM for Kipp to specialize in HB 133 Checking Net Content of Package Goods
 - In April he will train all Nevada W&M Inspectors as well as three out of state inspectors
