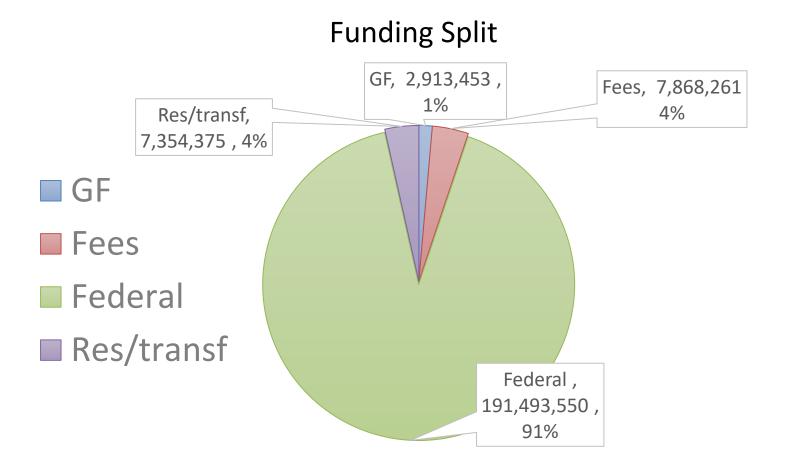

General Fund FY18

- Commodity Foods \$100k
- Food & Nutrition \$130k
- Plant Health & Quarantine \$1.2mil
 - Gov Initiative
- Vet Med Services \$1.1 Mil
- Admin \$370k (off set fees)
- PARC \$0



General Fund FY18 cuts

- 5 percent \$130,000
- Increase Match for Fed \$100,000
- Lowest impact to Public Safety and Interstate Commerce with cut of \$230,000 from PARC account or 3 positions
- Increase need in Animal Disease staff & maintenance of effort of equipment and staff \$185,000 (1 FTE & Equipment)
- Increase need in Staff in Admin & maintenance of effort \$320,000 (two FTE and IT equipment) (SWCAP)
- Gov Initiates for Drought (\$800k in FY 18 and \$200k in FY19)

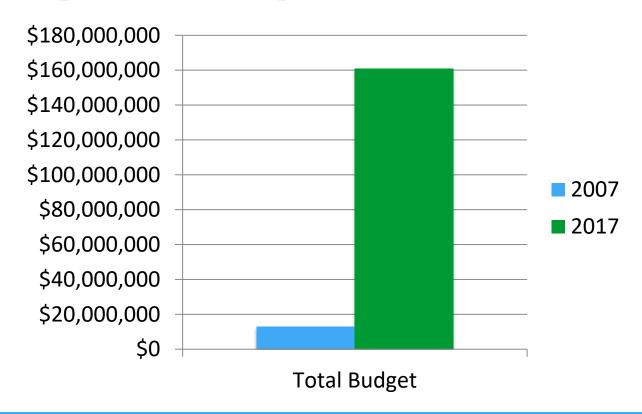

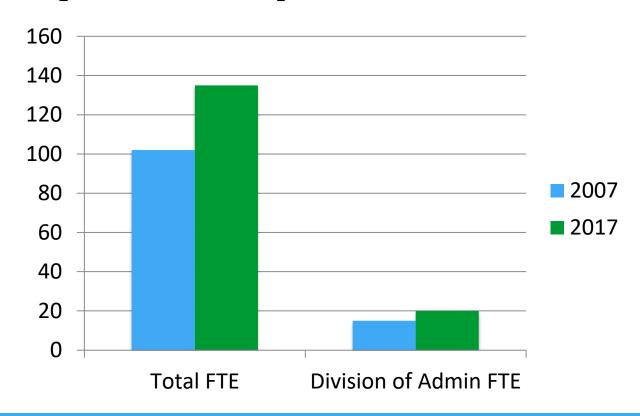
