1-Call to order, roll call of members and establish a quorum

8-Sesqui Centennial-Carson City Fair presentation and request for approval of the show and use of NJLS equipment

The board was informed the Carson City Fair will be held from July 30th through August 3rd. It was requested that the board let the fair use NJLS' panels from July 21st through August 8th. Ms. Chvilicek moved to grant use for the fair to use panels and all forms signed and adhered to, seconded by Mr. Richards. The motion was passed.

Mr. Richards moved to approve Frank Chavez as the Spring Office Aide, seconded by Ms. Chvilicek. The motion was passed.

10- Board Member Appointees
