Please send pictures of the weeds (if available) to nvweeds@agri.nv.gov. Pictures can assist with identification and documentation. Images of the whole plant, leaves, stem and the flower are most helpful. Please write the address or location of the property with the weeds in the subject or body of the email so they can be matched with the complaint. Note: Due to email size limitations please do not send individual emails over 6 MB. Instead, send multiple emails with one or two pictures a piece.
