Division Overview

- Submitted initial draft regulations to LCB for proposed amendments to NAC chapters 581 and 582. A workshop was held on December 8, 2020. The hearing to adopt the regulations is anticipated to be scheduled for early January 2021.

 - FY21 total items calibrated: 870
- Petroleum Technology
 - FY21 total samples tested: 993

- Weights and Measures

 - FY21 package and price verification inspection hours: 46.5
 - FY21 repair orders issued: 243

Industry Impact

- Las Vegas Metrology Laboratory
 - As reported to the Board in March 2020, the Las Vegas metrology laboratory will close as of the end of December 2020. Metrology program personnel have been coordinating with industry to prioritize services in Las Vegas for southern Nevada customers whose standards have certificates that will expire in late 2020 or early 2020.
