- o Budget
 - Governor's Recommended budget pulled the agency-wide inspection program from consideration due to funding obstacles.

 continued unchecked growth in the population of Nevada wild horses is having a
 negative impact on the agriculture community, in addition to the negative
 environmental impacts to the ecosystem.
