Pending matters of significance

- The Nevada Department of Agriculture (NDA) will be hosting the 2024 Governor's Conference on Agriculture on November 20, 2024, at the Rafter 3C. The meeting will precede the 88th Annual Nevada Cattlemen's Association Convention and Tradeshow. Learn more and register at agri.nv.gov/GovCon.
- The NDA is extremely proud to announce that as of June 1, 2024, all full-time NDA state employees had completed their Nevada state employee required training. To our knowledge, this is the first time in history that NDA was 100% compliant in required staff trainings.

Partnership activities

- The NDA partnered with the Reno Aces in support of Nevada's craft beverage industry. A portion of the proceeds from the game went back to the Nevada Craft Beverage Passport to promote the industry.
- The NDA partnered with Made in Nevada for a Made in Nevada Connections networking event in Las Vegas on Aug. 20, 2024.

Program Updates

Trade and Economic Development

- The NDA had a 'Taste of Nevada' pavilion at the Seoul Food & Hotel Trade Show, consisting of five (5) Nevada food manufacturers June 10-14.
- Held a 'Taste of Nevada' food sampling in Toronto, Canada June 15-17, featuring a variety of Nevada products, including Nevada lamb.
- The Director and Senior Trade Officer attended the Select USA Summit in Washington, D.C. June 24-26 to discuss new economic development opportunities affecting Nevada agriculture.
- Held foreign delegations from South Korea, Vietnam and Malaysia in Nevada July 10-12, to meet with hay, alfalfa and animal feed producers in Eureka, Fallon and Lockwood.
- Attended the North American Agricultural Marketing Officials (NAAMO) conference in Asheville, NC July 21-25. Senior Trade Officer, Dillon Davidson was elected to serve the international organization as President.
- The Craft Beverage Passport was submitted to an international marketing excellence award competition and took first place.
- Senior Trade Officer, Dillon Davidson, testified in a Senate Subcommittee on Tourism, Trade and Export Promotion hearing on July 30th, related to challenges and opportunities for rural exporters in Nevada.
- Three Nevada pet food companies exhibited at the Super Zoo Trade Show in Las Vegas, August 13-16. Met with a delegation of buyers from South Korea.
- Held foreign delegation meetings from Canada and Mexico August 19-20 in Las Vegas and Reno to meet with consumer-oriented food producers.
