Program Updates

Food Distribution

The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP)

- TEFAP clients continue to receive food through the Food Bank of Northern Nevada (FBNN), Three Square Food Bank (TSFB) and their network of community partners. Between Oct 1st and Dec 30th, 3,668,780 pounds of TEFAP food was distributed throughout the state. There were 504,642 individuals served in this time frame, with an average of 168,214 individuals served each month.

Senior Nutrition and Wellness Program (SNWP)

- SNWP served an average of 4,650 seniors from October to December 2025, providing monthly food packages to income-eligible seniors 60 years of age and older.

Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP)

- Program year 2026: NDA will conduct agency training in March.
- Coupons will be distributed to agencies in southern Nevada in April.

USDA Foods

- Trucks are delivering food items on time. Continuing to order with processors and USDA for National School Lunch Program (NSLP) food items.

Food Distribution Program on Indian Reservations (FDPIR)

- FDPIR distributes USDA Foods monthly to income-eligible households living on 10 Indian reservations/Tribal communities.
- Our program specialist has been focused on certifying additional recipients that are eligible for the program. The number of individuals certified increased these three months from the previous quarter, partially due to the federal shutdown and SNAP benefits being paused.

American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funding

Food Insecurity: Rural Food Hub Grant

- Increases food storage and distribution capacity in rural Nevada. To date \$1,539,372.35 has been reimbursed to Food Bank of Northern Nevada (FBNN) of the \$3M they were awarded. Sub-grantee has awarded a contractor to complete reno. Construction will include renovations to current building and facility improvements. Project planned to be completed by September 30, 2026.

Nevada Community Food Access Grant (NCFA)

- NCFA Round 2: State ARPA funds enhance food access statewide in rural, tribal and underserved urban communities. Partners continue to work to complete their projects.
 - Six (6) of the 14 agencies awarded completed their projects and expended all grant funding.
 - Five (5) agencies are working on completing their projects.
 - Three (3) projects were de-obligated due to agencies being unable to fulfill the remaining project goals.
 - Of the \$6M awarded, \$749,409 is left to be expended.

Home Feeds Nevada

- Program continues to be on hold, giving the two food banks time to distribute the additional foods purchased because of the federal shutdown and pause in SNAP benefits. Three Square in Las Vegas still has overflow food in both our warehouse and the Purchasing WH.

Las Vegas Warehouse

- We officially moved into the new Placid St. warehouse in January. We are now using only this warehouse for all our dry, cold and frozen food in southern Nevada.

Community Nutrition

Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP)

- Number of meals served from October 31, 2025, through February 27, 2026: 1,934,780* meals served.
- Administrative/Compliance Reviews completed: 9 sponsor/operator reviews in progress.

Summer Food Service Program (SFSP)

- Number of meals served from October 31, 2025, through February 27, 2026: 0 meals served. SFSP is a seasonal program and will resume in May 2026.
- Administrative/Compliance Reviews completed: 0 sponsors/operators were reviewed, SFSP reviews will resume in June 2026.
- Sponsor trainings have been completed for the upcoming summer and we are gearing up to get ready for summer 2026.

National School Lunch Program (NSLP) & School Breakfast Program (SBP)

- Breakfast Meals Served November 1, 2025, through January 31, 2026: 4,023,790*
- Lunch Meals Served November 1, 2025, through January 31, 2026: 7,376,623*
- Administrative/Compliance Reviews completed: 6 sponsors/operators were reviewed.
