- Partnered with the Governor's Technology Office to fully restore functionality across all department systems following the statewide cybersecurity incident.
- Worked closely with the Governor's Office, Department of Human Services, Nevada National Guard, Division of Emergency Management, Food Bank of Northern Nevada, Three Square, The Just One Project, state legislators, and other partners to coordinate the state's response to urgent food distribution needs amidst the SNAP benefit gap caused by the federal shutdown.

- Working with Chair of RSCVA on draft management agreement for Nevada State Fairgrounds.
- Continued partnering with the Nevada Junior Livestock Show Board, 4-H, FFA, Nevada Agricultural Foundation, the Reno Rodeo Association, and other groups in planning efforts for the Nevada Department of Agriculture (NDA) State Fair in June of 2026, pursuant to Nevada Revised Statutes 551.030.
- Nevada received the signed cooperative agreement from USDA to implement the State Meat and Poultry Inspection Program, expanding in-state inspection capacity and boosting market access for small and midsize meat producers.

#### Executive

- Attended Governor Lombardo's Natural Resources Sub-Cabinet and full Cabinet meetings.
- In partnership with the Nevada Western Heritage Center Alliance, appeared before the Reno-Sparks Convention and Visitors Authority Board of Directors to emphasize the need for strategic investment to revitalize the State Fairgrounds and unlock its full potential as a regional destination for promoting Nevada agriculture.
