Re: Grazing and/or Public Land and Materials Sales Sequestration Amounts

Dear Sir or Madam:

As you are likely aware, mandated spending reductions known as sequestration went into effect on March 1, 2013. The Department of the Interior was required to apply these reductions to all programs, projects, and activities that were not specifically exempt from the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 (BBEDCA), as amended by the Budget Control Act of 2011 (BCA; P.L. 112-25). Payments made under Section 10 of the Taylor Grazing Act of 1934 and Sale of Public Lands and Materials pursuant to Public Law 136 of 1951, were not specifically exempt, and thus are subject to sequestration.

As such, we must apply mandated reductions to payments previously made on December 12, 2012. The total amount for the impacted Taylor Grazing and Sale of public land and Materials) sequestration is \$18,199.68, which is based on \$356,856.45 x 5.1 percent. Accordingly, we must recoup \$18,199.68. Unless you respond otherwise, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) will automatically reduce your next payment from this account by the amount noted above. You also have the option of making a payment to the BLM within 30 days. Please notify the BLM by September 13, 2013, if you select this option, and you will receive a bill upon request.


As noted above, the Department of the Interior must comply with the BBEDCA and the sequestration reductions resulting from the terms of the BCA.
