- Workforce development
  - The Nevada Women's Farm2Food Accelerator workforce development program kicked off on November 2 with 16 women, representing an array of 10 agribusinesses, seeking to launch or expand a value-added food or beverage product into new markets. This project is in partnership with the National Association of State Departments of Agriculture Foundation and funding through the Nevada Specialty Crop Block Grant and the American Rescue Plan Act.
