

Law Enforcement Bias Indicators and Warning System Policy

Policy 3.2



POLICY

Per Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 561.105, the Board of Agriculture shall establish the policy of the Nevada Department of Agriculture (NDA).

The policy shall ensure the establishment of an early warning system, known as the Law Enforcement Bias Indicators and Warning System, to identify peace officers who display bias indicators or other problematic behavior. This policy shall ensure the guidelines for the Law Enforcement Bias Indicators and Warning System meet applicable Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) and Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) and are applied in a professional, impartial, and reasonable manner.
