Expectations: NJLS Show Interns will actively assist with Show and Sale operations. This can include but is not limited to distributing t-shirts, organizing and distributing awards, facilitating thank-you letter signing, show office assistance, herdsmanship, setting up and tearing down show rings and pens, weighing in animals, etc.

Dress and Conduct: Interns should wear long pants, boots, or other protective close-toed footwear and a youth-appropriate t-shirt or button-up long-sleeve shirt. No mid-drift tops, sandals, or inappropriate graphics on clothing will be tolerated. Interns represent the Nevada Junior Livestock Show Board during work hours and should conduct themselves appropriately, refraining from vulgar language and behavior.
