- NJLS rules recommendations:
  - o WQCA changes- Quality assurance training w/ renewal every 3 years
  - o Must use age level and specific to species (change in language)
  - o 4-H staff trained in person facilitators (Recommendation to the board)
  - o Novice division rules change/clearing up language in rule book
    - Change to first time showing ANY species (in general)
    - With exception of a county qualifying show held that year
    - 1<sup>st</sup> time exhibitor
    - Do not allow Novice to move onto round robin (already shown in round robin specific rules)
    - Delete "Exhibitors showing..." Paragraph (No Novice will be allowed to move up in division just based on experience even placing 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup>)
    - (Other divisions, must pick one division to show in, then allowed to move on with written consent with UNCE 4-H personal)
    - Taking out judge from showmanship entry rules on pg. 8
  - New language asks kids to commit to round robin
- Shared comment with Matt in regards to research getting hogs to butcher with less stress
- Recommendation for live transport with mobile slaughter (Swine)
- Pg. 9 Feeder show entries
  - New lang. animal is automatically feeder, may not be shown in homegrown market class
  - Addition; Exhibitors may list 2 large market animals and 2 small market animals regardless of species (1 small animal and one small animal may be sold)
  - o Can enter 2 large and 2 small, but can only sell 1 small and 1 large

  - o Take out the words "In the future"=period will be placed after 'occur'.
- Pg. 16
  - BOLD PRINT
- Pg. 17
  - Add on agreement adding 's'
  - o Scholarship animals deleted from rule book (SCHOLARSHIP ADVISORY)

- Pg. 31
  - Ewe with lambs; must be current years prodigy, may bring in market animal if app. For this class (Eliminates 2 classes and puts in into 1)
  - o Flock=5 animals
  - o All entry form deadline change to March 1
  - Grammar spelling errors
- Pg. 32
  - o Entry fee in \$20.00/entry; each allowed 2 large and 2 small
  - o 2 individual birds OR one turkey and one rabbit entry
  - o Request to reinstate rabbit meat pens instead of single fryers.
    - Will eliminate exhibitors
    - Have to have one or the other, not both
    - If switched, if pen doesn't qualify cannot allow one of those animals to sell/show as an individual. If don't make weight, they're out.
    - Exhibitor numbers decrease=loss in money.
    - Recommendation: Leaving as single fryer, no meat pens
  - o Fixing wording on Turkey showing (clarify on turkey meat pens)
  - o Eliminating Turkey Meat pens (end of pg. 39 and onto 40)
- Pg. 41
  - o Enter all turkeys into 1 class
- Educational displays recommended to move away from south arena perimeter
  - o Final say: Leave as is
- Showmanship conflicts
  - No changes will be made
- Pee Wee ribbons
  - o Funding (?)
  - Sponsoring
- Can we have a dairy animal or breeding animal sale?
  - o No.
- Letter
  - Will be a board discussion
  - Douglas county 4-H letter
  - Putting in a rule that any animals that go through our show cannot be showed in any other market show (live release animals).
  - California's rules-No junior exhibitor cannot show a market animal as a market animal twice.
  - o Putting into the words that work for NJLS
  - o (Any animal sold on a live release cannot be sold again)
  - Recommendation: Use California's rule at NJLS (youth livestock) will forward to board after changing language.
  - o Dennis will send out letter to other board members
  - Will be addressed at board meeting in October.
  - o Meeting will be October 24

- o Anita would have to come to the meeting
- o Sarah will send a letter to Anita regarding her presence at next meeting.
- o Enforcement?
  - If found out that exhibitor does this, could result in ban from showing at NJLS in future years.
  - Consequence will be written within the rule
  - Provide other fairs and shows sale lists (Public records)
  - Exhibitor violating this rule may be banned from attending other NJLS.
    (Violators will be brought to the NJLS board for review)
- Gates Locked
  - Need to make people aware about perimeter gates locked at 11
  - (Welcoming committee not really rules committee issue)
