## Requirements for pasture cattle entering Nevada. Division of Animal Industry



All livestock entering Nevada for pasture must meet Nevada's brand inspection and health requirements.

- 1. If the livestock are to run on public land or will be branded in this state, then the brand must be recorded as a temporary pasture brand. The form to record a temporary brand is on this website under "Forms" or you can call the Elko Office at 775-753-1360 or email <a href="mailto:livestockinspection@agri.nv.gov">livestockinspection@agri.nv.gov</a>.
- 2. For health requirements and entry permits. Please call NDA at 775-353-3709 or email entrypermits@agri.nv.gov.
- 3. For "Pasture to Pasture Permits" call 775-353-3709 or email entrypermits@agri.nv.gov.
- 4. All out of state livestock owners are required to pay the annual Nevada Livestock Assessment Tax. For additional information please contact the Elko office at 775-753-1360 or email <u>livestockinspection@agri.nv.gov</u>.
- 5. Nevada Revised Statutes do not recognize the California "50 Mile" Permit for any livestock entering or leaving Nevada.
