

2026 Eligibility Criteria  
Senior Farmers' Market Nutrition Program  
Division Food & Nutrition



**Purpose:**

To increase the consumption, production, and distribution of fresh, locally grown fruits, vegetables, herbs and honey, while supplementing the nutritional needs of Nevada's low-income seniors.

**Eligibility:**

Must be a Nevada Resident, 60 years of age or older with household incomes at or below 185% of the poverty income guidelines.

## Year of Birth for Qualifying Seniors = 1966

(Example: For booklet issued on April 1<sup>st</sup>, qualifying Senior must have been born on or before April 1, 1966.)

### 2026 Income Eligibility Guidelines

Household Size	Annual Income	Monthly Income
<b>1 Senior</b>	<b>\$29,526</b>	<b>\$2,461</b>
<b>2 Seniors</b>	<b>\$40,034</b>	<b>\$3,337</b>

Note: Decimals are rounded up to the nearest dollar/cents on guideline table.

1. Local Agency must make sure to have senior complete the self-certification form. At this time also give them a copy of the rights and responsibilities handout.
2. After Local Agency reviews self-certification form make sure to let senior know if they are approved or denied. If they are denied explain why and offer them the appeal procedures.
3. If the senior is approved, give them the coupon booklet, a copy of the farmer market locations, food eligibility list, and the nutrition education handout.
4. Also explain to the senior how they can make a complaint about a farmer if they need to do that throughout the season.
