Prior to receiving USDA food each household must certify that their household's current income does not exceed the amounts listed below. This guideline is in accordance with 185% poverty level issued by the Department of Health and Human Services. Misrepresentation of need, sale or exchange, or misuse of USDA foods is prohibited and could result in a fine, imprisonment, or both.
