<b>Boys &amp; Girls Club of Truckee Meadows</b>	BGCTM recently expanded their service area in Winnemucca and Humboldt County. This project will support a backpack program in Humboldt County, which will provide take-home food for 575 children in rural and Tribal communities. BGCTM will also deliver weekend back packs throughout the summer in Fernley and in White Pine County. The project will support these efforts through infrastructure purchases and supplemental food purchases.	Washoe County and Rural Northern Nevada
<b>Boys &amp; Girls Club of Western NV</b>	BCGWN will provide up to 1,000 additional snacks and meals to children and their families in Carson City and Douglas County through December 2020. The project will restore the BGCWN's meal service in Douglas County, which was suspended due to the pandemic, and previously provided food to 150 children each day.	Carson City, Douglas County
<b>Carson Valley Community Food Closet</b>	The project will enhance food storage and distribution infrastructure at the Carson Valley Community Food Closet, allowing for the receipt and storage of an additional 125,000 pounds of food to respond to increased need as a result of the pandemic. <b>Catholic Charities of Northern Nevada</b>	CCNN will purchase locally-grown food for distribution to food insecure Nevadans, expand its home delivered meals and pantry boxes to immuno-compromised clients, and increase deliveries to its urban, rural, and Tribal pantry partners. CCNN will partner with Urban Roots to provide window-sill garden kits and garden information to recipients of food through CCNN. The project will also enhance CCNN's food distribution infrastructure in Washoe County. The project will support food assistance to an estimated 20,000 individuals each month in Washoe, Elko, Winnemucca, and White Pine Counties.	Washoe County and Rural Northern Nevada
<b>Community Services Agency</b>	CSA will partner with 12 affordable housing complexes in Washoe County to provide home delivery of food to 200 vulnerable seniors and people with disabilities each month. The project will support these efforts through supplemental food purchases, equipment, and staff support.	Washoe County

<b>Culinary Academy of Las Vegas</b>	The Culinary Academy of Las Vegas will partner with the Just One Project to deliver 2,000-3,000 bags of nutritious food each week to families in need. Up to \$540,000 of additional food will be purchased for distribution in the greater Las Vegas area during the project period.	Greater Las Vegas
<b>Fallon Food Hub</b>	Fallon Food Hub will expand the Great Basin Basket Farm Share program by purchasing local produce to provide an additional 100 produce boxes each week to food-insecure families in Churchill County. FFH will supplement produce with shelf-stable foods and provide recipes and food safety materials. The project will support these efforts through food purchases, equipment, and staff support.	Churchill County
<b>Helping Hands of Vegas Valley</b>	HHOVV will serve 900 additional seniors and homebound clients per month through the home-delivered groceries and home-delivered meals programs through December 2020. The project will support the expansion of home-delivered food services through supplemental food purchases, infrastructure support, and staff support.	Greater Las Vegas
<b>Mineral County Senior Services</b>	Mineral County Senior Services will purchase supplemental food for home delivery to seniors in Mineral County. The project intends to provide bi-monthly home deliveries of shelf-stable food to food insecure seniors in Hawthorne, Walker Lake, Mina, and Luning. The project will also support staff efforts and travel costs associated with home delivery.	Mineral County
<b>Northern Nevada Dream Center</b>	NNDC will expand food pantry, mobile distribution, and home delivery to populations in need in Carson City, Douglas County, Lyon County, and Storey county. NNDC will also provide meal delivery to the homeless community in Carson City. The project will support these efforts through infrastructure, staff support and some food purchases. <b>Organization</b>	<b>Project Summary</b>	<b>Service Area</b>
<b>Ron Wood Family Resource Center</b>	RWFRC will establish mobile food pantry distributions at 4-6 low income apartment complexes in the Carson City area, serving up to 300 families each month. RWFRC will also provide home delivery of groceries to up to 40 families per month. The project will support these efforts through equipment, food purchases, and staff support.	Carson City
<b>UNLV Food Pantry</b>	This project would support the UNLV Food Pantry during the pandemic by providing software to allow for online ordering of food to maximize safety and provide supplemental food and equipment. The UNLV food pantry currently serves 250 students and staff each month.	Greater Las Vegas
<b>Washoe Co Human Services Agency</b>	Washoe County will purchase five delivery trucks equipped with hot and cold storage capacity to support safe home delivery of food to Washoe County seniors. The project will support home delivery of an estimated 8,800 meals each week.	Washoe County
