Steps to receiving a state phytosanitary certificate

Contact NDA to receive a phytosanitary certificate



Is the product a raw agricultural commodity / live plants?



Product may need an alternative certification



Is the product still available for inspection (i.e. hasn't been mailed/shipped)?



Product cannot be issued a phytosanitary certificate



Applicant creates a USDA PCIT Account (PCIT FAQ found here). Applicant then creates an application for state phytosanitary certificate.



Both links are clickable. One takes you to the USDA PCIT (Phytosanitary Certificate Issuance & Tracking System) website and the other takes you to the frequently asked questions page.

Application for state phytosanitary certificate is submitted to a state office in PCIT. Please use one of the following options, whichever is closest to your product. NV: Sparks (State) | NV: Las Vegas (State) | NV: Elko (State)



Inspector from closest state office will contact applicant for scheduling. Please be sure to submit the application in a timely manner, NDA needs 1-3 business days to schedule inspections. Does your product meet the importing state requirements?
