Failure to complete the appropriate weed mitigation measures can result in a certificate being terminated, revoked or denied for renewal. Weed mitigation measures are outlined on the certificate of inspection and may also include additional instructions or communication.

___ that meeting all of the North American Invasive Species Management Association (NAISMA) minimum standards is a requirement of Weed Free Certification. These standards are available for review at naisma.org.

___ that meeting all requirements established by the NDA in addition to the NAISMA minimum standards is a requirement of Weed Free Certification.

___ this agreement is valid unless the following circumstances apply:

- I request termination in writing via letter or email
- the NDA issues an updated or revised version that needs to be re-signed
- A non-compliance condition is identified, resulting in the suspension or termination from the NDA Weed Free Certification program
