


Barbed/Jointed Goatgrass in Nevada



Barbed and Jointed Goatgrasses are non-native winter annual grasses which can spread rapidly. Barbed goatgrass and Jointed Goatgrass are closely related to each other and other wheat species, capable of hybridizing and are often contaminants in winter wheat seed. These grasses may reduce wheat quality and yields if introduced in agricultural fields, and may negatively affect native rangelands.
