DDVP and Bed Bugs

Recently the Department of Agriculture (NDOA) was asked to evaluate the licensing category for pesticide products containing DDVP, (dichlorvos and 2,2-Dichlorovinyl dimethyl phosphate) which is currently on the market as Nuvan® ProstripsTM for the control of flying insects and now Bed Bugs. The Pest Control Enforcement section of the NDOA has reviewed Nuvan's technical data, pesticide label and supplemental labeling for their pesticide product. As long as a Pest Management Professional uses the Nuvan® ProstripsTM according to label directions and any supplemental labeling directions, a Nevada C2 (Industrial and Institutional) license would be appropriate.
