The applicant shall pay a non-refundable application fee of \$900.00 and:

- Outdoor operations must pay an acreage fee of \$5.00/acre or portion thereof.
- Indoor operations must pay a square footage fee of \$0.33/1,000 square feet or portion thereof.

Applicant is also responsible for (fees are based upon an approximation of actual costs of the inspection and tests):

- inspection rate of \$60.00/hour /inspector for drive time, inspections, and sampling,
- mileage, which will be charged at the current IRS reimbursement rate,
- any analysis that may be conducted by the NDA.

The NDA will request payment for the appropriate amount calculated above once the application is reviewed and approved. Any payment submitted prior to NDA request will be returned.

Initials	that a certificate cannot be transferred or assigned to another business, individual, or entity without a revised application submission and approval by the NDA.
Initials	that all hemp plant material shall be planted and harvested within the certification period listed on the hemp grower certificate. The Department must be notified if material, propagative or not, is still present after the permit period has ended. Permits expire on December 31 of each year.
Initials	that each noncontiguous land unit, with which hemp shall be grown, will be associated with a separate application. Any additional acreage or square footage will be associated with a separate application.
Initials	that no registered land area may contain <i>Cannabis spp</i> . plants or parts thereof that the registrant knows or, has a reason to know, are of a variety that will produce a THC content greater than the acceptable THC limit (not to exceed 0.36% for the 2022, 2023 and 2024 production year) as defined by NAC 557 on a dry weight basis, unless otherwise approved of by the Department of Agriculture. No registrant shall use any such variety that is known to produce THC concentration levels above the acceptable THC limit (not to exceed 0.36% for the 2022, 2023 and 2024 production year) on a dry weight basis.
Initials	to allow any and all inspections/sampling that NDA deems necessary to validate the applicant's compliance with state and federal regulations. All compliance testing is performed by the NDA.
Initials	to pay for costs on the oversight of this program. Payment must be submitted within 30 days after invoicing.
Initials	that THC concentrations for hemp must not exceed the acceptable THC limits as defined through NAC 557 through a post-decarboxylation or similarly-reliable test method on a dry weight basis to be sold. The NDA has adopted Total Potential THC, an approved method by USDA. <u>Crop that does not meet these standards will be subject to crop disposal</u> . that any information provided to NDA can be utilized for public disclosure and be provided to law enforcement agencies without further notice to the registrant.
Initials	any operations proposed to use land that is not owned by the applicant must be accompanied by a signed, notarized affidavit from the legal owner of the land consenting to approval.
 Initials	alterations of any kind to this application will require a \$150.00 amendment fee. Application details must stay consistent with all production features at all times or certification can be denied or revoked.
Initials	that applicant is in good standing with state and federal programs and does not have any outstanding payments or any unresolved non-compliances.
Initials	that applicant has acquired appropriate water rights for agricultural production.
Initials	that sufficient notice of approximately 45 days prior to intended harvest, in the form of a Hemp Harvest Report, will be issued to the Department to allow for sampling to be scheduled 30 days prior to any harvest. Those who submit timely notice of intended harvest will receive inspection priority.
