[Assembly Bill 411](#) of the 81st Session of the Nevada Legislature requires the State Board of Agriculture to adopt regulation specifications for motor vehicle fuel which allow for the sale of gasoline containing up to 15 percent ethanol by volume. This fuel is commonly referred to as E15.

In preparation for drafting of initial proposed regulations amending Chapter 590 of Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) to allow for the sale of E15 in Nevada, the Nevada Department of Agriculture (NDA) will host an informational session to gather input from industry and stakeholders.
